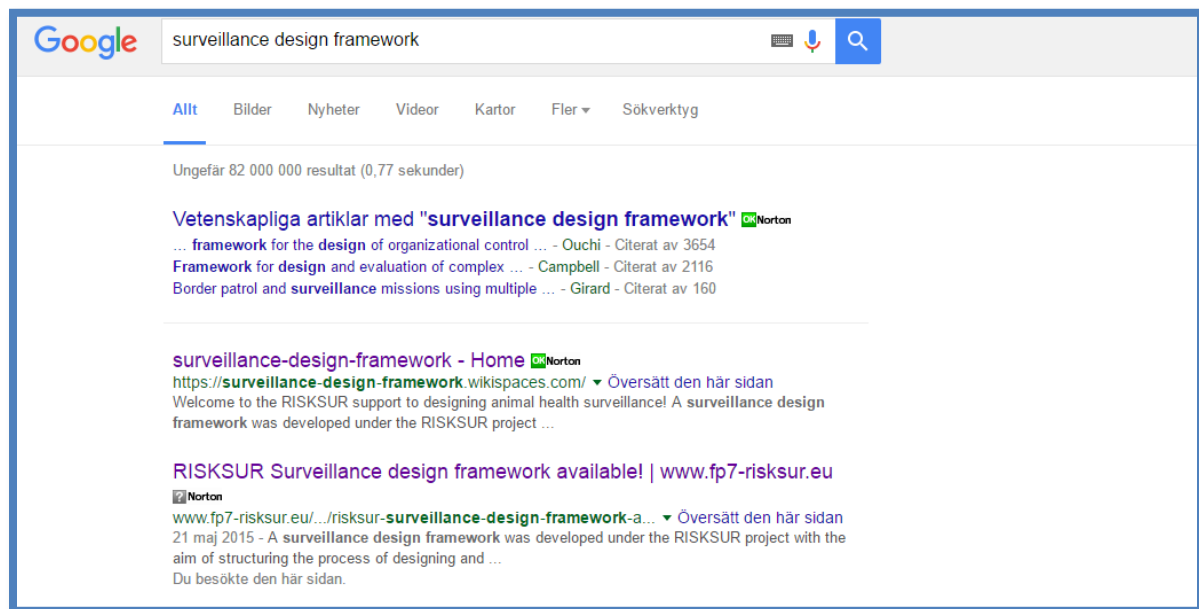
Accessing the WIKI as a NON-MEMBER

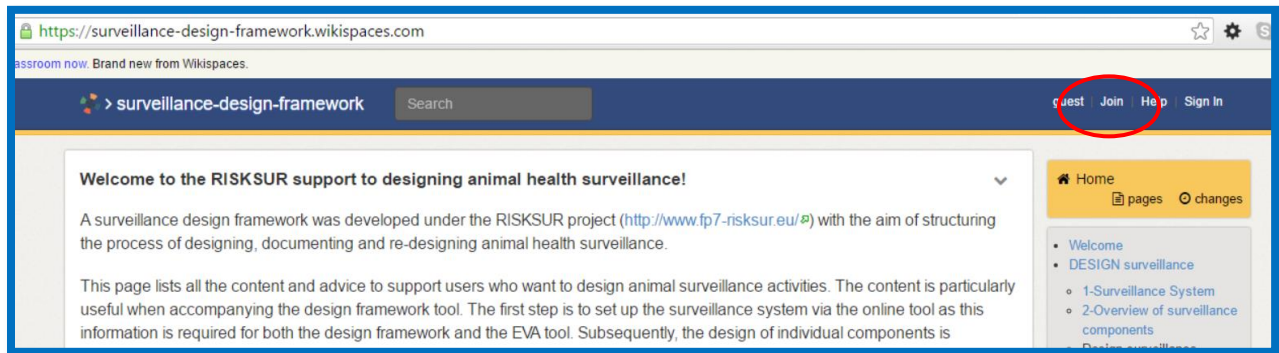
For example, the WIKI comes up when a user searches for „surveillance design framework“



Joining the WIKI as a MEMBER

- 1) Access the WIKI through the links
 - Design tool <https://surveillance-design-framework.wikispaces.com/>
 - Eva tool <https://surveillance-evaluation.wikispaces.com/>

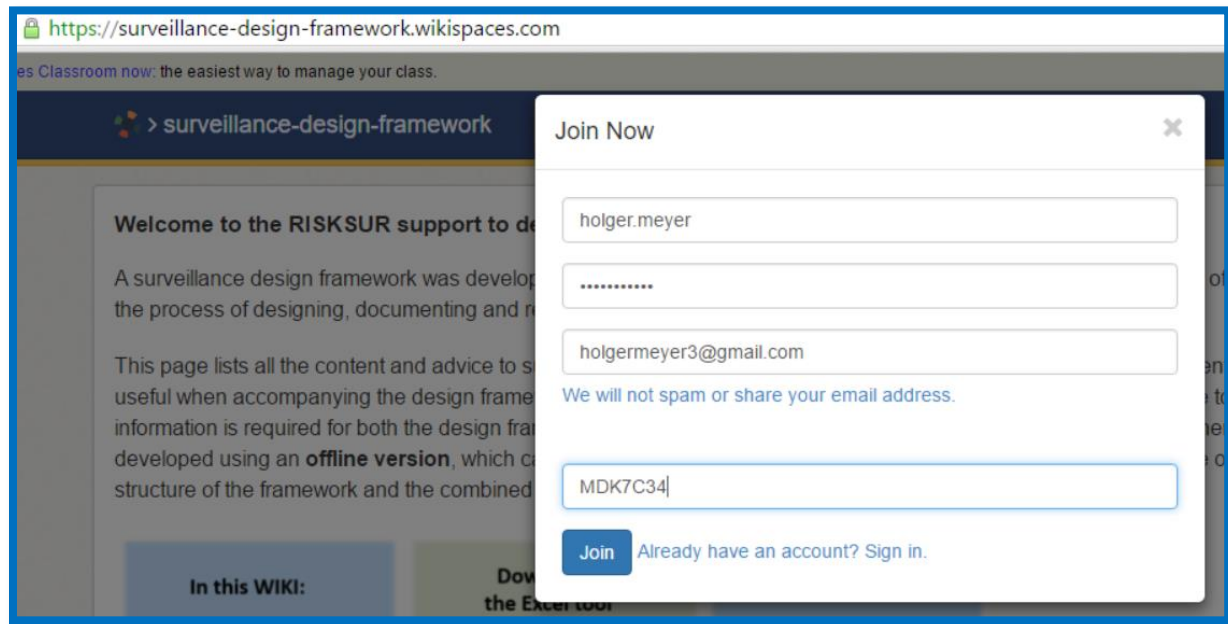
- 2) On the top right, click JOIN:



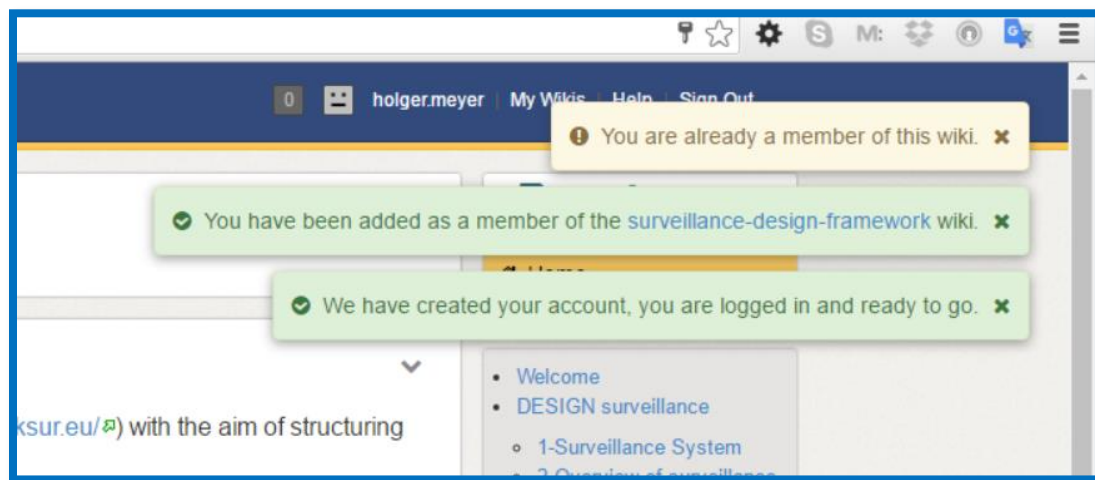
If the „join” button is not present, please sign out. And restart from step 1.

- 3) Joining is super quick and requires no step of verification through the email. Just provide a user name and a password, and type in the code we will have provided.

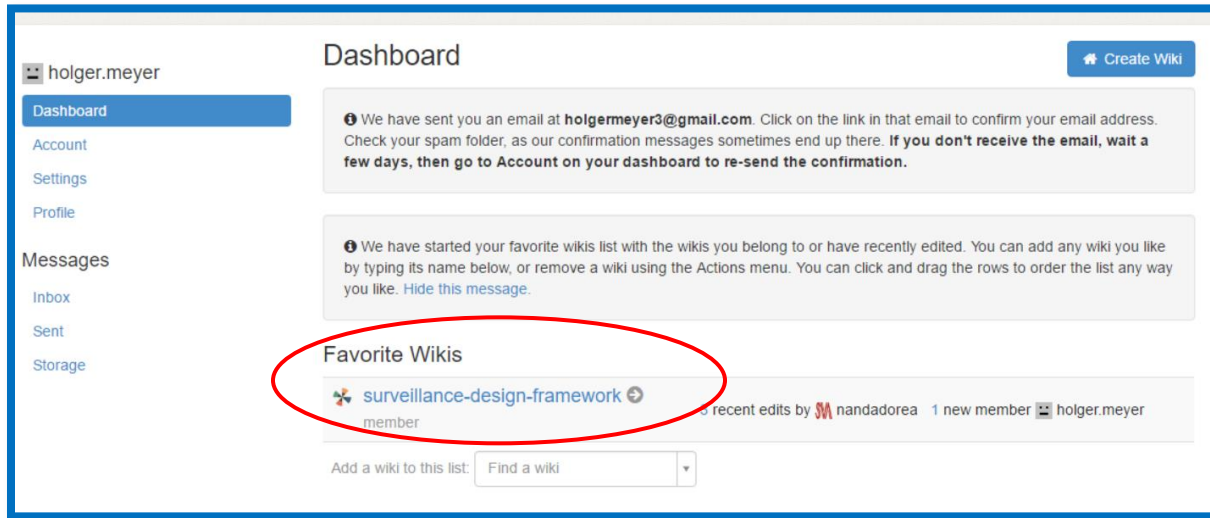
Please note that these codes will expire after 7 days.

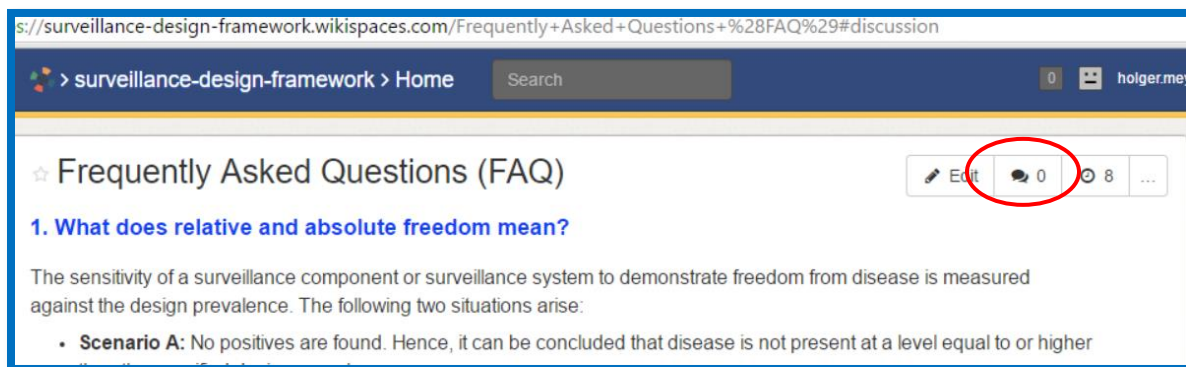
- 4) If you click on your name, on the top right, you are taken to your user account. Here, BOTH wikispaces would be readily reachable, once you sign up for both.




Click on the wiki name to go back to the wiki content.

- 1) Navigate to any page, and on the top, click in the speech balloons to be taken to the discussions area

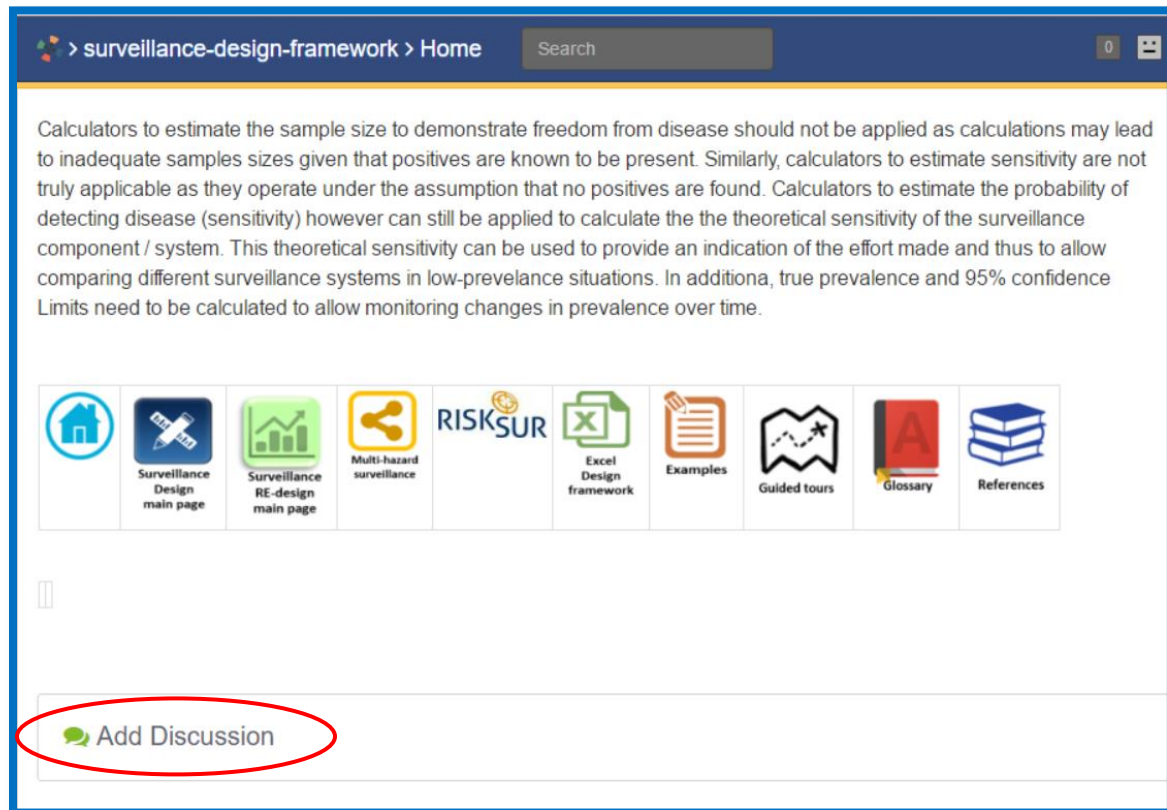


